



#### Is your child up-to-date with vaccines?

August is National Immunization Awareness Month, and this is a great reminder to keep your child up-to-date with their shots. Is your child up-to-date with theirs?


Vaccinations help your child stay healthy by providing an extra layer of protection against infections and complications like pneumonia, ear infections, and meningitis. Some of these diseases can be life threatening. In fact, childhood vaccinations are estimated to save 4 million lives worldwide every year.

These can be especially valuable for very young children. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that all children get the following vaccinations before their second birthday.

- Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis (DTaP)
- Polio
- Flu • Hepatitis A & B
- Chicken Pox
- Pneumococcal
- Rotavirus
- Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) • Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (Hib)


#### Get a reward card for up to \$50 for your child's after school activities!

Getting your eyes checked should be a key part of your yearly wellness visit. This is especially important if you have diabetes, because you are at risk of getting diabetic retinopathy. Diabetic retinopathy can lead to vision loss and blindness. With diabetes management, these annual exams can help your doctor spot early signs of eye disease before they become severe.

In addition, you can get rewarded for taking steps to manage your diabetes and keeping track of your health with our Healthy Rewards Program.
