
Keep away the flu, colds and **RSV**!

Cold, flu, and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) season has arrived! Our top priority is keeping your family healthy.

Symptoms for the flu, colds, and RSV can range from mild to severe, including a runny nose, sore throat, fever, vomiting and diarrhea. If your child has these symptoms, schedule a visit with their provider as soon as possible.

In addition to getting your flu and RSV vaccines, here are some helpful tips to keep your family healthy:

- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
- Wash your hands often, and be sure to use both soap and water.
- If you are sick, stay home and avoid contact with others.
- Reduce the risk of getting sick with good sleep, a balanced diet, and moderate exercise.



The place to start is with your primary care physician. They can help you decide what to do next.

You can also call our <u>24-Hour Help Line.</u> You'll be able to talk to a registered nurse and get advice around the clock.

Have an online health care visit with a provider through Texas Children's Anywhere Care. Texas Children's Anywhere Care can help you get an online appointment with a health care provider.

If you have a life-threatening or serious emergency, you should go to the nearest emergency room or call 9-1-1.
