


Spring is in the air: Managing **Asthma**

Asthma is a leading chronic illness among children in the United States.

If you or your child has asthma, it's important to know how asthma medication works to help improve symptoms.

Two types of medication, known as "relievers" and "controllers," are used in the treatment of asthma. Reliever medication works fast and is used to treat severe symptoms. Controller medication works slowly over time and is taken every day, even if you or your child feels well, to try to stop asthma attacks




Planning to grow your family?
